

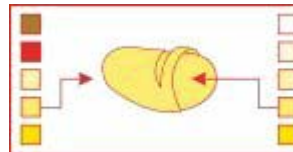
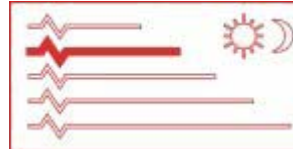
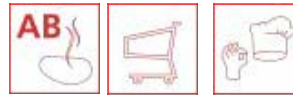

## General production advice ware potatoes

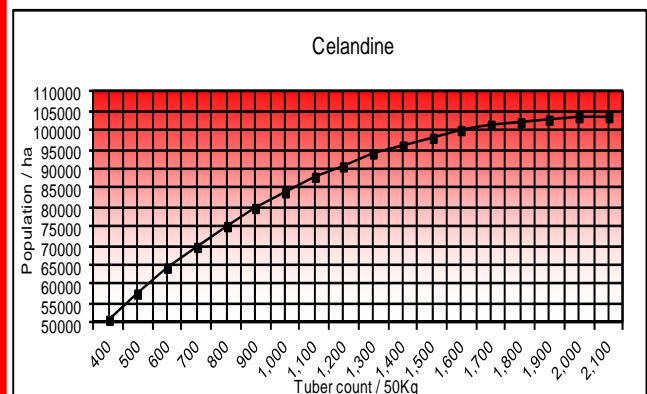

## Fertiliser

Nitrogen requirements comparable to an Maris Peer Crop. Advise 120-150kg/ha N. Apply the majority of the Nitrogen in the seedbed.

Phosphate and Potassium rates use standard RB209 recommendation.

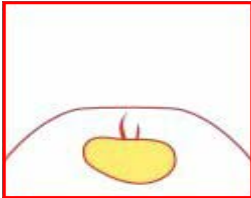

## General production advice ware potatoes

### Pre-treatment and planting



Do not plant the Celandine directly from cold store but allow the seed to acclimatise to outdoor temperature.

Plant deeper than soil level for more efficient use of water and nutrients, and to help prevent greening and tuber blight.

Tuber and or soil treatments are advised to control Rhizoctonia and other soil

### Growing attention points



Celandine is sensitive to Sencorex (Metribuzin) use pre emergence only.

Celandine is a first early variety and therefore will naturally mature at burn down and set skin very quickly

### Haulm killing and harvest



Skin set will be achieved quickly on Celandine providing the crop was mature at burn down. Aim for a timely harvest to minimise skin diseases.

### Storage



Celandine has a long dormancy, and is suitable for mid to long term storage.
