These plant population guidelines are for irrigated crops in the absence of PCN.

FERTILISER ADVICE

Courage needs 10% more nitrogen than average. Also a little extra Potassium is recommended.

SPECIAL ATTENTION POINTS

The crop has to be fully mature before haulm killing, otherwise there is a risk of sugar defects. Although drought resistant for a crisping variety, Courage is sensitive to common scab, therefore irrigation is still beneficial. Courage is not suitable for the long term storage.
