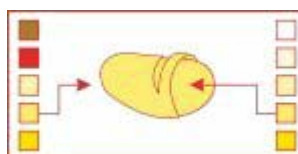
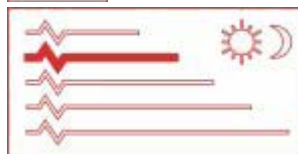


General production advice ware potatoes

- * Fast skin set



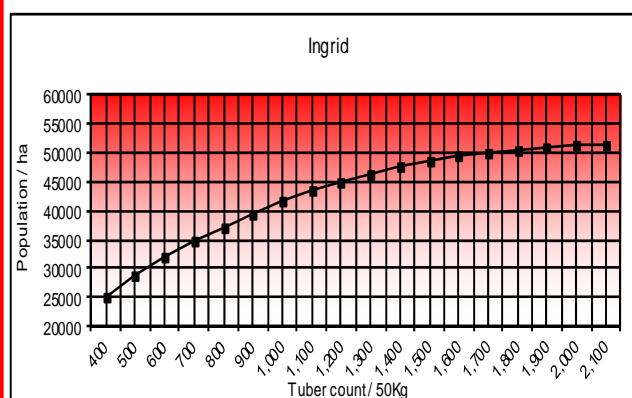

Click on Density chart for full size

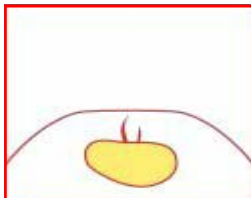
Fertiliser

Nutrient requirements are similar to Premiere. Advise 200kg N/ha including soil supply. Not necessary to use split applications of N.

Phosphate and Potassium use RB209 recommended rates

Pre-treatment and planting



Ingrid is suitable for a range of soil types although heavy bodied soils may result in misshapen tubers..

Ingrid will respond positively to physiological ageing, particularly if aiming at an early market.

If sprouted ensure that soil temperatures are above 6°c at planting to minimize the risk of Little Potato Disorder

Tuber and or soil treatments are advised to control Rhizoctonia and other soil borne skin diseases. The variety is not susceptible to greening, therefore can be planted at a soil level to encourage rapid emergence.

Growing attention points



Sencorex is safe to use pre and post emergence, in normal circumstances

Ingrid has a slight susceptibility to foliar blight, use a robust blight programme, in conjunction with specific chemistry to control Alternaria.

Haulm killing and harvest



Ingrid is a robust variety which sets its skin quickly. It can therefore be harvested either green-top as a loose skin pack potato or left to mature and packed as early set skin.

Storage



Ingrid has a good dormancy, although the variety is mainly used off the field.
